CAMP HILL, Pa. (July 28, 2023) — Twenty-four community-based organizations across the state have been awarded a combined \$410,000 in grants from United Concordia Dental, a subsidiary of Highmark Inc., to help enhance educational opportunities for students through Pennsylvania's Educational Improvement Tax Credit (EITC) and Opportunity Scholarship Tax Credit (OSTC) programs.
